

Every Tour Guide Needs to Know!!

(1) Souvenirs

We need CA to advise and direct students **NOT TO** play with the souvenirs they purchase from the Global Bazaar. All items must be kept in the bag and not to play with during the program. Playing with the souvenirs (Some even make noise!!) has become distracting. At the request of our presenters, please be attentive to this manner. **CA may need to remind students constantly!!**

(2) From Station # 5 to Station #1

There are two areas in station # 1 – **one for Latin America** and **one for Europe**. Students should have already been divided into two groups before entering these two areas. Teachers have been advised to do so before they come for the field trip. However, there may be a possibility that teachers forgot and also there are some groups that combine many different schools. Please then quickly work to divide students equally into two groups to enter these two areas separately. Each area only has 25 minutes and then need to rotate with each other. Visit station # 1 is for one hour.

(3) From Station #1 to Station # 2:

This area may be a little bit complex since students will float around at their own pace for one hour. This is how it would work well:

- (1) Get together **in the lobby area** to introduce what we have for **station 2: Lunch, Bazaar, Arts/Crafts, Magic/Puzzles, Games/toys; Altogether, they have 50 minutes!!**
- (2) Students move to area of interest freely. However, be cautious that shopping at the bazaar has to wait till the hallway is clear for students who move from station 4 to 5.
- (3) All of the students **must eat lunch!! Foods of Korea, Thai and Philippines are available.**
- (4) Encourage students to come back **Saturday** to take time to explore more hands-on activities fun.
- (5) Ambassadors need to go around reminding students to move around to explore all activities.
- (6) Teachers will turn in their complimentary lunch tickets to get a plate and drink and go around to pick whatever food they like from food vendors. Other adults (not for students) need to pay \$6 for the same plate and drink.

(4) Regarding the Survey

When CA arrives at the conference center, surveys will be passed out to you. Your input provides us with valuable insights we can use when preparing future presentations. Azalea International Folk Fair is committed to providing a valuable cultural experience program for our school systems. We value your comments deeply and will work hard to exceed your expectations. Please be most generous to share your ideas with us.

(5) Lunch

Regretfully, not like the last four years (2004 – 2007), we **WILL NO LONGER** be able to provide free lunch for the cultural ambassadors.
