

(4) Judging Criteria & Score Sheet

1. The contest will be judged by a panel of **5** judges consisting of either technology/engineering instructors or professionals with insightful years' experience in technology and engineering. They are selected by the Azalea International youth Invention Organizing Committee. The list of judges will be announced on website on January, 2010.

Website address is www.GAinternationalfolkfair.org.

2. The Judging Rules and Criteria are decided & set by the panel of judges assigned by the Azalea International Organizing Committee.

3. The winners who will be decided by the Panel of Judges for annual IEYI event are decided by two factors:

(a) The top highest scores awarded by the judges based on the Judging Criteria. Each team's final score is calculated by averaging all five judges' scores for that team.

(b) The grand award for overseas trip will be limited to two winners who study in the state of Georgia and will best represent U.S.A. for the worldwide, annual International Exhibition for Young Inventors.

4. Winners will be recognized in the Valdosta Daily Times and on The Fun Channel.

5. **The decision of the judges is final and binding.**

6. At the end of the competition, all 5 judges' scores will be given to the team.

The teams need to pick up their score sheets on site.

We will not mail the sheets.
